Speech Engine Initialization Error

Relative to NaturallySpeaking version 10.x

Background:

To improve the recognition speed, Dragon NaturallySpeaking 10 was designed to use SSE2 technology. This new requirement for Dragon NaturallySpeaking 10 reduces computation time and latency for fast speakers. SSE2 is supported by almost all processors sold since 2006, but some systems that meet the processor speed requirement do not support SSE2.

Symptoms:

When attempting to open Dragon NaturallySpeaking, the following error is displayed:

A Serious Error occurred while initializing the NaturallySpeaking speech engine

Cause: Typically, this means that the processor (CPU) of the computer does not support SSE2 instructions. Dragon NaturallySpeaking 10 requires that the processor support SSE2 in order to run properly.

Solution:
