DNS 9 Medical Vocabularies

Background

NaturallySpeaking 9 includes vocabulary groups which encompass many medical specialties and subspecialties. All of the vocabulary groups contain a large dictionary of medical terms. Each specialty vocabulary adds additional, highly specialized words to the base medical dictionary for the group. More importantly however, each specialty vocabulary contains statistical modeling for the group that provides higher out-of-the-box accuracy that goes far beyond the simple addition of specialized words.

Obstetrics/Gynecology	fetal medicine, midwifery, obstetrics/gynecology, ophthalmology, otolaryngology, perinatology, reproductive endocrinology
Oncology	diagnostic radiology, oncology, radiation therapy
Orthopedics	dentistry, ENT surgery, hand surgery, neurosurgery, ophthalmology surgery, oral surgery, orthopedics, plastic surgery, podiatry
Pathology *	Pathology
Pediatrics	neonatology, pediatric dentistry, pediatric endocrinology, pediatric ENT, pediatrics
Radiology *	nuclear medicine, radiology
Surgery	bariatric surgery, breast surgery, cardiac & thoracic surgery, colon & rectal surgery, general pediatric surgery, proctology, surgery, trauma surgery, urology, vascular surgery
